Meanwhile, it is necessary to understand the changes that Industry 4.0 and the Internet bring to the fastener industry.

The whole industry should keep expanding to new fields. It should continue to reform and stay open, improve steadily, and promote development and economic

transformation, so that the fastener industry can continue healthy development to accomplish the goal of the 13th Five Year Plan.

China’s fastener output has topped the world. In 2016, its output was more than 7.45 million tons (representing 40% of the world’s total) and the sales amounted to 75 billion (about 1/8 of the world’s total). Compared to other Asian and advanced countries, there’s still a huge gap on the average unit price. Due to the complicated world economic trend, the impact of global financial crises, trade protection and tariff barriers in some countries, China as a big fastener exporting country has faced challenges in international trade.

China’s fastener industry has made significant improvement with its effort in international trading disputes over the past decade. President Xue said that, China would like to collaborate with the world, unite with European fastener manufacturers and traders, increase communication and trust, promote mutual collaboration and seek mutual development to fight against trade protectionism.
