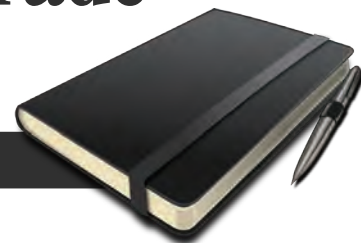

03/28-30 *Fastener Fair Stuttgart* **2661**



The world's leading exhibition for the fastener and fixing

industry will take place in halls 1, 3 and 5 at the Stuttgart Exhibition Grounds in Germany. The new hall increases the available net exhibition space to 20,500 m², enabling a further growth of the exhibition by currently 7% compared to the previous event. To date around 790 companies from 41 countries secured their stands at the 7th International Exhibition for the Fastener and Fixing Industry. Germany, France, Italy, the Netherlands, Spain and the United Kingdom are the major European exhibitor countries. Asian exhibitors mainly come from Turkey, China, India and Taiwan.

This exhibition covers all areas of the fastener and fixing industry: Industrial fasteners and fixings, construction fixings, assembly and installation systems as well as fastener manufacturing technology. The show targets distributors, suppliers, engineers and other industry professionals.

Fastener Fair Mexico will bring together international manufacturers of fastener and fixing technologies and suppliers of machines and tools with distributors, suppliers, engineers and other industry experts from Mexico and Latin America. Mexico is the second largest economy in Latin America and is facing increased

demand for fastening and fixing solutions for the aerospace, automotive, construction and electronic and other fast growing industries.

Almost 2,000 qualified buyers from 20 countries, including Argentina, Brazil, Canada, Chile, Guatemala, Peru, Spain, Taiwan and United States, attended Fastener Fair Mexico 2016. Buyers came from all over Mexico. For the 2017 edition, over 2,000 fastener decision-makers from Mexico and other countries are expected to attend, including fastener or fixing distributors/suppliers, manufacturers, and end users, all from key industry sectors such as automotive, distribution, construction, electrical products and domestic appliances.

“The 2nd Manufacturing World Nagoya”, the sister show of Manufacturing World Japan with 27 years history (Asia’s largest scale) will be launched again at Portmesse, Nagoya, one of the centers of manufacturing industries in Japan. In the 1st edition, the show gathered about 700 exhibitors and 29,236 visitors from all around the world. Reasons to launch the 1st edition in Nagoya were strong requests from existing exhibitors to hold an exhibition in central Japan to widen sales, inquiries from automotive/aerospace/machinery/medical device manufacturers in Nagoya area, and growth potential of the region.

Exhibits include motion technology/motor, fluid power transmission/ tube components, mechanical parts & related products, fasteners / mechanical springs, material fabrication technology/surface treatment, deburring & industrial cleaning, testing/measuring/sensor. Visitors are mainly design & development engineers, R&D personnel, production engineers, manufacturing engineers, maintenance engineers, procurement managers, quality control professionals, management executives.



05/17-20 Subcon Thailand

The 10th successful edition resulted in outstanding success and no other show can match the international event’s coverage and success. It is the only exhibition organized by the Thailand Board of Investment and UBM Asia (Thailand). The total number of trade visitors for the four day event was 23,091. More than 300 first-class part- makers from 9 countries were featured at the 2016 exhibition. They

included major National Pavilions from Japan, plus the TAITRA Pavilion, Fastener Pavilion, Mold and Die Pavilion by Thai-German Institute along with ASEAN Supporting Pavilions from Singapore, Malaysia, Philippines, Vietnam and Myanmar.

The number of business meetings generated by the Business Matchmaking program jumped from 4,611 to 5,216 pairs for 2016. The final tally for business transactions exceeded 8.6 billion Baht, with more expected in follow-up deals. B2007**06/22-24 Fastener Expo Shanghai**

Fastener Expo Shanghai 2017 is Asia's largest and the most influential fastener show and its exhibits include standard and non-standard parts, industrial fasteners, fastener manufacturing technology & facilities,

molds/dies/consumables for fasteners, raw materials, related products and technology, etc. With the increased demand for new products from downstream industries, it is expected that the show scale next year will reach another peak, with the floorplan reaching 50,000 sqm and over 800 exhibitors.

In 2016 the show attracted 25,625 visitors from 43 countries including USA, Australia, South Africa, Brazil, Mexico, Russia, Italy, Germany, France, the Netherlands, UK, Spain, India, Korea, Japan, Iran, Malaysia, Singapore, UAE, Indonesia, Vietnam, Philippines, Pakistan, Saudi Arabia, Thailand, Cambodia, Taiwan, and Hong Kong. The floorplan spanned the area of 42,000 sqm. In 2017, the show organizer will also open the 3rd hall and add "Building Hardware & Construction Fasteners Area".

Over the past few years, DesignBUILD has firmly established itself as an industry nexus, leveraging partnerships with peak industry

bodies and new industry alliances to deliver an event that is a true reflection of what industry collaboration can do. For the first time, DesignBUILD will co-locate with long-term partner, the Australian Institute of Architecture's National Conference, creating an architectural hub at the new International Convention Centre (ICC), Sydney.
