SINPA

Brazilian Fastener Institute (SINPA) is the Association of Employers of the "fasteners manufacturing economic category, legally constituted to defend the segment's common interests."

In the first half of 2012, the global economic dynamics goes unstable. In terms of any changes of the fastener market distribution in the local market in the same period, " Since our export is not significant that most production tends to supply the domestic market, the influence on industry will be the same influence on the wider economy," commented José Gianesi, the President of SINPA.

In the next half of 2012, SINPA will hold its regular Board and Plenary Meeting on October 4 and December 13. On the other hand, the Plenary Meeting will be directed on September 13 and November 8.
