Greatest Moments to Remember: Fastener World in 1992

Back in the autumn of 1992, the biennial "China International Fastener Industrial Show" was held in Shanghai, China. Companies from Taiwan, Spain, Belgium, Hong Kong, and many other countries came to exhibit their latest products, making the venue crowded with exhibitors and visitors. In addition, in order to congratulate the show for being so successful and facilitate tech info exchange and international interaction, former Chairman of Taiwan Industrial Fasteners Institute (TIFI) Mr. Te-Nan Sun bringing a delegation consisting of 32 Taiwanese companies and former Chairman of the Fastener Institute of Japan (FIJ) Mr. Yoshiaki Hujimoto with his Japanese delegation paid a visit to former Chairman of the Fastener Sub-division of China General Machine Components Industry Association (CMCA) Mr. Xiao-Shan Lee on-site, showing their respect to him. The meeting of these 3 fastener leaders from the industry was big news at that time.

In 1991, the Fastener Cable and Wire Show Korea was also held in Seoul. 120 companies from 16 countries booking 210 stands registered for exhibiting. Taiwanese exhibitors including Tung Kuang, Chun Zu, Hung Li, and Huei Shang also came to exhibit. This int'l show was a new experience at that time for Korean suppliers who still focused on domestic sales.

The young and industry-recognized genius Mr. Yung-Lung Tsai of Jinn Her Enterprise worked hard in developing markets with his other two brothers in the 1980s, making Jinn Her one of the largest Taiwanese fastener manufacturing exporters. He even became the first one to invest NTD 0.5 billion in establishing Chin Well Holdings Berhad in Malaysia, hoping to become a successful worldwide recognized fastener company.
