The new laboratory is equipped with the most advanced instruments in the industry that can process image measurement, dimension/vibration/pullout/hardness/ thickness testing, and is even equipped with a screw assembly tester, which is rarely seen in Taiwan, to provide customers with good quality control. If customers have new product development ideas, Bossard also has a professional technical team that can assist in product development and give advice, which not only allows customers to significantly reduce the cost of self-development, but also focuses on the practicality of products, performance, safety and efficiency to make the most appropriate improvements.
