Import

In the first 10 months of 2025, U.S. imports of fastening tools showed divergent trends and supply chain restructuring. Imports under HS code 8204 grew, with Taiwan maintaining its position as the largest source, while China's share declined significantly. Emerging suppliers like Vietnam, India, and Thailand expanded rapidly. Imports under HS codes 8205 and 8207 saw slight declines, but China's share continued to shrink. Japan and Southeast Asian countries experienced growth, indicating a shift in import structure from cost-driven sourcing toward a balance of quality, technology, and supply stability.

Export

In the first 10 months of 2025, U.S. fastener exports declined overall, reflecting external demand and adjustments in key markets. Exports under HS 8204 fell 5.36% year-on-year, with notable declines in Canada and Mexico, while the UK, Australia, and some European markets maintained modest growth. Exports under HS 8205 dropped 8.48%, with N. American and UK markets contracting, but Japan and the Netherlands showed double-digit growth, indicating continued competitiveness in high-quality markets. HS 8207 exports experienced the largest decline at 14.01%, with decreases in Canada, Mexico, and Saudi Arabia. However, Germany, the Netherlands, and Japan bucked the trend with growth, reflecting steady exports of high-precision and technology-driven products.

Import

Canada's imports of fastening tools in the first 10 months of 2025 showed slight fluctuations and diversification of sources. Imports under HS 8204 increased marginally by 1.33%, with stable supply from China and Taiwan, declines from the U.S. and Japan, and rapid growth from Vietnam and Thailand. Imports under HS 8205 dipped 1.96%. China remained the largest supplier, while the U.S. saw a decline exceeding 13%. India and Vietnam recorded significant growth. Imports under HS 8207 decreased by 3.61%. The U.S. and Germany experienced declines, but Japan and India bucked the trend with growth, reflecting stable supply of high-value-added products.

Export

In the first 10 months of 2025, Canada's fastening tool exports exhibited market segmentation and diversification trends. Exports under HS 8204 saw a slight decline, with the U.S. market showed a slight decline while Australia, Kazakhstan, France, and Turkey recorded significant growth; Exports under HS 8205 increased, with growth in the U.S. and the UK, and rapid expansion in China, the Netherlands, Brazil, and the UAE. Exports under HS 8207 saw a slight decline, with decreases in the U.S. and Mexico, but counter-trend growth in Kazakhstan, Brazil, Germany, China, and Spain. Overall, this indicates that Canadian exports are diversifying from traditional N. American and European markets toward emerging markets and high-technology demand markets, with enhanced export resilience for high-value-added products.

Import

HS 8204 saw a 3.76% increase in value and a 22.26% increase in volume. China remains the largest supplier, while imports from India, the U.S., Germany, and the Czech Republic grew significantly; Vietnam and Turkey experienced declines. HS 8205 increased by 10.17% in value and decreased by 8.07% in weight. Imports from China slightly declined, while those from the U.S., Germany, Spain, and the Netherlands expanded rapidly, with a higher proportion of high-value-added products. HS 8207 saw a 12.66% increase in value and an 11.98% increase in weight. China, Japan, and Germany showed notable growth, while the U.S., Vietnam, and Singapore experienced declines. Overall, Taiwan's imports are transitioning toward diversification and high-tech, high-value-added products. Total imports are growing steadily, but the distribution of sources is becoming more fragmented.

Export

Taiwan's fastening tool exports showed a slight decline in 2025. Exports under HS 8204 decreased marginally by 1.39% with stable shipment weights. The U.S. and China remained primary markets, while emerging markets like Indonesia recorded notable growth. Exports under HS 8205 fell by 6.01% with shipment weights dropping nearly 9%. Demand in N. America and Europe moderated slightly, while exports to China and Japan remained stable or edged up. Exports under HS 8207 decreased by 3.99%, with a 17% reduction in weight. China and Russia experienced notable declines, while the U.S., Vietnam, and Malaysia continued to grow. Overall, total volume showed a slight decrease, but export markets are shifting from mature markets toward high-growth and technology-driven markets.

Import

In the first 11 months of 2025, Japan's total imports of fastening tools remained stable compared to the same period in 2024, with slight increases of 0.1% in value and 0.91% in volume. China remained the largest supplier, with imports rising 4.62% in value and 3.14% in volume. Imports from Vietnam, Thailand, Switzerland, and India showed steady growth, indicating expansion from emerging and high-value-added sources. Conversely, imports from Taiwan, South Korea, the U.S., and Indonesia declined, with the U.S. and Indonesia experiencing drops exceeding 20%. This reflects a decreasing reliance on traditional, mature suppliers. Overall, the trend shows stable total volumes, diversified sourcing, and an increasing proportion of high-value-added products.

Export

In the first 11 months of 2025, Japan's total exports of fastening tools increased by 7.99% in value and 5.82% in volume, showing an overall upward trend. The U.S. remained the largest market, with demand surging by 27.81% in value and 45.41% in volume. Exports to China, Thailand, and Mexico also grew steadily. Exports to India, Taiwan, and Germany saw significant surges in value, rising by 548.6%, 1,648.5%, and 2,287.3% respectively, indicating rapid expansion in demand for high-value-added and technology-driven products. Exports to South Africa and Canada declined, reflecting regional fluctuations in demand.

Import

HS 8204 imports saw a slight decrease of 0.96% in value but a 24% increase in weight. China maintained steady growth, while the U.S. and Italy recorded modest increases. Taiwan and Germany experienced declines. HS 8205 imports rose by 8.94% in value and 22% in weight. China, Hong Kong, and the U.S. showed significant growth, whereas Taiwan and some European countries declined. HS 8207 imports saw a slight decrease of 1.5% in value but a 12% increase in volume. China and Sweden recorded growth, while Japan, South Korea, and Türkiye experienced significant declines. High-value-added products rely on a limited number of suppliers. Overall, Brazil's imports are increasingly concentrated among Asian suppliers. The volume increase indicates expanding demand, but the sources of high-value products remain diversified.

Export

Exports of HS 8204 increased by 16.41%, with growth in Bolivia, Peru, and Paraguay, but declines in Argentina and Uruguay. Exports of HS 8205 plummeted by 56%, with declines in Colombia and the Dominican Republic, but Saudi Arabia and Bolivia bucking the trend with growth. Exports of HS 8207 remained largely stable overall, with South Africa surging by 86% while the U.S. and Argentina saw significant declines. Overall, Brazil's exports exhibit characteristics of substantial growth in a few markets alongside fluctuations or declines in major markets, reflecting both market diversification and the risk of reliance on single buyers.
